#### To Our Neighboring Businesses and Community Partners,

Situated in the heart of Tampa's Downtown, Sacred Heart Catholic Church has been serving parishioners, visitors, and the local business community since 1905. Sacred Heart is the first Catholic Church in Tampa and Florida's west coast, with a parochial history stretching back to Tampa's early pioneer days. Our parish serves the neighborhoods of Hyde Park, Downtown Tampa, Davis Islands, Harbor Island, Tampa Heights, Riverside Heights, and parts of Old Seminole Heights and South Seminole Heights.

As a Franciscan parish, Sacred Heart and its congregation are very much in tune with the friars' devotion to justice, peace, and integrity of creation. The parish hosts more than twenty individual ministries that all take part in regular acts of service toward these ends, fulfilling a mission to cultivate a vibrant community of faith by creating meaningful connections with both God and each other. As an example, our Hands of Hope ministry, which provides necessities and meals to the unhoused each weekend, embodies the spirit of St. Francis, advocating for the vulnerable, promoting justice and peace, and reaching out to those who are alienated from the Church or society.

Sacred Heart's ministries rely on the time and treasure of our parishioners to carry out these objectives, with the parish providing the structure and venues to address the needs of our local community. One such venue is our historic North Campus, located about two miles north of the main church, in Tampa Heights. The campus was previously a school which operated from 1931 to 2012, and currently serves as the primary event space for our parish and operations center for our outreach ministries. Much of the campus' infrastructure, especially in the auditorium and adjoining kitchen, is original from the initial build and is in desperate need of renovation in order to continue hosting events like public meetings, our family faith formation classes, and ministry activities like the aforementioned Hands of Hope and their weekly meal prep.

Sacred Heart is proud to announce our 10th annual fundraising gala— "A Night in Assisi" hosted aboard the Yacht Starship on Friday, April 19, 2024. The evening will feature dinner and dancing, alongside live and silent auctions, with a goal to raise enough capital to continue the necessary improvements inside the North Campus kitchen and auditorium, which are underway.





# **Sponsorship Supports**

Our goal for the 2024 Gala is to raise the capital needed to continue the necessary improvements inside the North Campus kitchen and auditorium.

Formerly Sacred Heart Academy, a parochial school which operated for more than 80 years, Sacred Heart's North Campus is a near-10 acre property located along Florida Avenue, just two miles north of the church itself. As the growth in downtown has evolved, so too has our reliance on the North Campus as a new epicenter for both our parochial and outreach activities.

Our parish hosts nearly all faith formation classes and ministry meetings from the property, in addition to regularly scheduled donation drives for partnering non-profits, and our weekly outreach to the economically challenged and unhoused.

Sacred Heart is home to more than 20 ministries that take part in regular outreach activities with local non-profit organizations, in addition to parish-wide initiatives, with each embodying the spirit of Jesus' call to action in Chapter 25 of Matthew's Gospel.

With many of the facilities being original to the Academy's initial build phases, our parish has the goal of maintaining the history of the campus while updating areas to fit current needs. The ongoing renovation of the kitchen and adjoining auditorium's infrastructure is necessary to continue our ministries' existing outreach, and begin hosting events that will provide revenue for the parish to grow our outreach.

The ball is already rolling, as a firm has been hired to serve as our owner's representative, tasked with securing the various trades needed to renovate the kitchen. The renovation is estimated to cost \$750,000.
