### **Profession of Faith:**

**PRESIDER:** Please stand. And so, I  
now ask all of you here present:

Do you renounce Satan?

**ALL: *I do.***

PRESIDER: And all his works?

**ALL: *I do.***

PRESIDER: Do you believe in God,  
the Father almighty,
